Perhaps it's the decor – functional at best, and with a strange preference for tables that are either too high or too small – but we've often found this branch of Feng Sushi curiously quiet, despite exemplary service, superb sushi and a handy proximity to the bustle of Camden market. Purists might balk at chives and cream cheese on a menu that also features 'Japanese fish and chips', but stick to the classics and you can't go far wrong. Salmon and avocado maki were satisfyingly fat and fresh-tasting, and shiitake tempura was nicely crisp and not too heavy. Special mention should be made of the ingredients: tuna is line-caught and the salmon comes from an organic Loch Duart farm.
